Assistant, 1736, 1737, 1738, 1739, 1742, 1743, 1744, 1745, 1746, 1747, 1748, 1749, 1750, 1751, 1752, 1753, 1754, 1755, 1756, 1757, 1758, 1759, 1760, 1761. Judge of the County Court in New Haven County, 1737 to 1770. Major of the Second Regiment, 1739; Lieutenant-Colonel, 1748; Colonel, 1752.
