

Guidelines for Chaperones

Thank you for visiting us today at Connecticut's Old State House! Here are some guidelines that will help ensure that your students meet today's learning objectives.

- Please remember that the students will follow your lead. Please do not carry on private conversations while programs are going on.
- Because cell phones are distracting, please keep them turned off or on vibrate during your visit.
- Tours always stimulate conversation, but please remember that voices carry in large open spaces.
- Photography is permitted by adults as long as the devices used are silent. We ask that students do NOT take pictures during programs as it is disruptive to the learning process.
- Please be sure the group is on time for activities, lunch, etc.
- Keep the group together and with you at all times.
- Remember that the program is for the students. Please hold your questions until the end of the program.
- Please remember to assist all students, not just your own child. During activities, jump in to assist students!
- Please do not eat, drink, or chew gum in exhibit areas and historic rooms.
- Please make sure that students do not touch artifacts unless the museum educator indicates that it is appropriate.
