Connecticut Science Center 250 Columbus Boulevard

Wadsworth Atheneum 600 Main Street

Butler-McCook House & Garden 396 Main Street

It is a slightly longer walk (10 minutes) to the Butler-McCook House, which is located at the intersection of Main Street and Capitol Avenue.
