

Apart from Studies Authorized by the PRI Committee, PRI has been directed by the full legislature to perform a variety of functions including:

- Staffing the **Commission on Enhancing Agency Outcomes (CEAO)**,¹ charged with identifying savings of \$3 million in FY 10 and \$50 million in FY 11. Exceeded this directive by identifying \$470 million in savings across state government.
- Developing **Connecticut State Police Staffing Standards**.²
- Piloting of **results-based accountability (RBA)** using DCF Family Preservation and Supports.³ Led to subsequent requirement to use indicators established in the PRI report for the Children's Report Card.⁴
- Determining the **impact of mandatory minimum sentences on prison overcrowding**.⁵
- Identifying the advantages and disadvantages of the **powers and duties of the Connecticut Resources Recovery Authority**.⁶
- Collecting **dealer conveyance fee** information from all new and used car dealers in Connecticut.⁷
- Assessing the **Metropolitan District Commission (MDC)** Annual Report for compliance with specific criteria.⁸
- Preparing the three-year **evaluation of the state's tax incentives for recruiting and retaining businesses**.⁹
